- You must be able to demonstrate that you have organized a business venture and assumed the risk for it. This may have been a volunteer or paid position.

For example, you were able to raise money for a cause. The demonstration of your ability to network, and follow through and complete projects is important in your application process.

Eligible Students

Each recipient must be a senior member of his/her high school (any public/private from the SBBI sphere of influence) for **at least one year** and in good standing, either planning to enroll or already enrolled as a fulltime student at an eligible institution for this coming fall quarter/semester . Student must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average (demonstrated in the last two terms).

Applications received prior will not be considered (this is for future years ☺). And must present a clear business concept or vision for future venture(s).

Eligible Institutions

Eligible institutions include any public or private, generally accredited two-year or four-year institutions of post secondary education, including eligible vocational schools.

Conditions of Eligibility

A student having insufficient resources to meet the required educational costs at the institution in which the student has been accepted for enrollment will be the primary basis of determination for financial need scholarships awarded. These costs shall include: tuition, fees, books, supplies. Need shall be determined by examination of the student's budget and tax returns. If student is still living at home, parents' budget and tax forms should be submitted. All applicants must demonstrate educational potential. This criterion will be the primary basis of determination for entrepreneur scholarships. This may be demonstrated by high school, or additional demonstrations through church or other civic means to conduct business that is of a legal and either volunteer or gainful financially nature. Further, submission of a letter and references giving background information which demonstrates your business potential. Community involvement is an eligibility requirement for all scholarships. This can include all volunteer efforts with non-profits or service organizations that you have completed and documentation is appreciated.

Amount of Scholarship

The amount of each scholarship will be \$600. The award shall be for the period of one (1) academic year.
